Conditions of participation for events of the Wüest Partner AG (as of July 2022)

1. Validity

- 1.1 These conditions of participation apply to the implementation of our events.
- Registration for our event takes place via our online store at www.wuestpartner.com. In this respect, our General Terms and Conditions for the Online Shop apply.

2. Withdrawal, substitute participant

- 2.1 The participant can cancel his/her participation by letter or e-mail up to six weeks before the event without cancellation fee, thereafter up to two weeks before the start of the event for a cancellation fee of 50% of the participation fee. In case of later cancellation, the cancellation fee is 100% of the participation fee. We will immediately refund the participation fee to the participant, if applicable after deduction of the cancellation fee. The participant's right to name a substitute participant at any time remains unaffected.
- 2.2 The right to terminate for cause shall remain unaffected by the above provisions;
- 2.3 the declaration of termination can be declared by letter or e-mail.

3. Subject to change, cancellation of the event

- 3.1 We may as far as reasonable for the participants make changes in content, methods and organization (e.g. due to changes in law) from the originally planned agenda before or during the event. We are entitled to change the scheduled speakers
- 3.2 (e.g. in case of illness, accident) to be replaced by other qualified persons or to be omitted.
- 3.3 We may postpone, shorten or cancel the event at any time for good cause (including force majeure, insufficient number of participants or if speakers are unable to attend without substitution). Notification of

the participant about a shortening, postponement or cancellation will be sent to the contact details provided during registration.

4. Liability

- 4.1 Our liability for damages and reimbursement of expenses for slight negligence is excluded.
- 4.2 The above liability provisions shall apply to the same extent in favor of our executive bodies, legal representatives, employees and other vicarious agents.

5. House right

We exercise, if necessary together with or through third parties, the domiciliary rights during the event and are entitled to issue instructions in this respect. We may exclude the participant from the event in whole or in part if he/she disturbs the event and does not cease the disturbance even after threat of exclusion.

6. Data protection, photography and filming
